Dress Code

A. Expectations

Dress and grooming are important issues in creating a safe and orderly environment for staff and students. It is expected that all employees will set a positive example for students in their dress and grooming. The attire of professional employees will be judged in light of the following:

1. At all times dress should reflect the professional position of the employee and serve as an example for students.
2. Attire should be that which is commonly accepted in the community.
3. Clothing should be appropriate and should not interfere with the fulfillment of responsibilities or the orderly function and decorum of the workplace.

B. Application

It is the responsibility of school administrators and department supervisors to ensure that the above principles are applied equitably and consistently throughout the school division.
